BOTTOM LINE

The film was very difficult to watch. However, it was confirmed that he played right guard on offense and right guard on a six-man line on defense. He also excelled on special teams.

OFFENSE: Quick off the snap with excellent explosion. He was able to get great push into the second level of the defense. Hard hitter.

DEFENSE: The Spartans lined up in a 6-2 formation, with a 2-1 secondary. Emerson was the right guard. He lined up against Giants' center Mel Hein. Quick and alert, with excellent instincts. He seemed to be in on every play. He stopped runs up the middle and was quick enough to get to runs on the outside. Good pursuit on plays downfield. On one play, he was pushed back by Hein, but he quickly disengaged from the block and got in on the tackle behind the line of scrimmage. He also recovered a fumble in the first quarter.
